STATEMENT OF EXPERTISE:

I, Sergeant II Gregory Bruce, Serial No. 34511, am your affiant. I am currently employed as a sworn law enforcement officer for the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD). I have been employed by the City of Los Angeles for 15 years. I have been assigned to Internal Affairs for the past three years and six months, where I have taken part in hundreds of investigations involving ethics violations and the misconduct of police officers. My prior assignments were in patrol, where I have investigated and/or have made arrests on over a hundred cases involving forced sodomy, forced oral copulation, and forced sexual penetration. Prior to becoming a sworn officer of the LAPD, I worked as a Federal Agent with the Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS) for three years. As an NCIS Agent, I received training in crime scene analysis and investigated sexual assaults involving service members of the Navy and Marine Corps.

In addition to training received through the Los Angeles Police Academy, I have received training through Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) courses and/or in-service training, which included sexual assault investigations, computer crimes, and sexual predators. I have also been trained by subject matter experts in the field of Peer to Peer file sharing, and the investigation of crimes related to sexual assault. I have personally examined digital videos, videotapes, pictures and computer images, emails and cell phone text messages involving sexual assault and unethical behavior.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE:

On January 4, 2010, allegations of misconduct were brought to the
Department's attention when
that Police Officers Luis Valenzuela and James Nichols were involved in
sexual misconduct (CF No. 10-000151). In the initial statement of the
complaint, and the alleged that Valenzuela and Nichols, dressed in
plain clothes and driving a Volkswagen Jetta stopped her in November 2008.
Valenzuela got into the back seat with her, exposed his penis and wanted
to touch it. The Investigating Officer (I/O) of the case could not
locate for further details of the incident. The investigation was later
closed for lack of evidence. (Addendum 1)
On January 20, 2011, allegations of misconduct were brought to the
Department's attention when seemen reported to LAPD supervisors
that Valenzuela forced her to perform oral copulation on him in the back seat of
an undercover police vehicle, while Nichols sat in the front seat (CF No. 11-
000193). (Addendum 2)

When interviewed by Internal Affairs I/O Detective Christina Frus, Serial No. 32187, Serial Stated that she was walking down the street in Hollywood when Valenzuela ordered her into his undercover police vehicle by telling her he would take her to jail if she refused. The recognized Valenzuela and Nichols as two plain clothes undercover officers that she had had contact with before. Valenzuela exited the driver's seat and entered the rear seat next to Nichols slid from the front passenger seat to the driver's seat and

drove them to a secluded location. Valenzuela unzipped his pants and
exposed his erect penis and told to perform oral copulation on him.
Valenzuela told that if she refused, she would go to jail. Valenzuela
then grabbed by the back of her head and forced her to perform oral

going to jail." Nichols remained in the front driver's seat during the entire

On July 17, 2012, allegations of misconduct were brought to the Department's
attention when an unknown complainant left a voice message on the voice mail

of a Department Vice Hotline. The complainant alleged that unknown LAPD

officers were exchanging sexual favors from prostitutes in lieu of arrest (CF No. 12 002112). (Addendum 5)

The case was assigned to me (Affiant) on September 20, 2012.

During the course of my investigation, I had knowledge of I/O Frus' investigation of CF No. 11-000193. I thought the circumstances and location were very similar to the allegations of CF No. 12-002112. I was able to locate two additional victims, and and and I interviewed and

stated to me that Nichols detained her in February, 2005 for prostitution. Nichols, in uniform and driving a black and white police vehicle, drove to a secluded location and removed her handcuffs. Nichols exposed his erect penis. Although Nichols said nothing to her, felt that Nichols wanted her to perform oral copulation on him in exchange for her to not be arrested. Performed oral copulation on Nichols in fear of going to jail. When she finished performing oral copulation on Nichols, he released her from custody.

In July, 2011, was detained by Nichols a second time. Nichols, in plain ciothes and in an unmarked undercover vehicle, drove her to the same secluded location as the first time, and again removed her handcuffs. Nichols exposed his erect penis and told "You don't want to go to jail today, do you?" The felt that if she did not perform oral copulation on Nichols that he was going to arrest her and take her to jail. "performed oral copulation on Nichols and again was released from custody. "Was able to positively identify Nichols from six pack photograph line-ups. (Addendum 6)

Stated to me that she was a CI for Valenzuela and Nichols from February, 2010 to April, 2011, when they were assigned to Hollywood Narcotics. During that time, Valenzuela told that if she had sex with him that he would take it into consideration when working off her arrest. Thad sexual intercourse with Valenzuela on two occasions. The first occasion was in March, 2010, while Valenzuela was off duty at apartment, in Los Angeles. The second time was in August, 2010, in the back seat of a Department undercover police vehicle while Valenzuela was on duty, in Los Angeles. Stated she had sex with Valenzuela because she was afraid that Valenzuela would send her back to jail if she refused. Valenzuela exchanged numerous text messages, phone calls, and emails with the on her cellular phone and computer while she was a CI. Many of the text messages and emails were sexually explicit. Was able to positively identify Valenzuela from a six pack photograph line-up. (Addenda 7 and 8)

Hollywood and Nichols was no longer working in the Hollywood Narcotics Unit. She thought that Nichols remained at Hollywood Division working patrol. Nichols contacted and continued a working relationship with her. Nichols told that he would cancel her working obligation to him if she would have sex with him. Thad sexual intercourse on two occasions in fear of going to jail if she refused. The first occasion was at a Los Angeles hotel in September, 2011. The second was at her apartment on April 13, 2011, in Los Angeles. Between September, 2011 and April 13, 2011, Nichols exchanged numerous text messages and phone calls with the on her cellular phone.

told me that the texts could be easily identified because she gave

Valenzuela the nickname of "Trubs" and Nichols the nickname of "Nicky", which were used during the texting. Many of these text messages were sexually explicit. (Addendum 9)

was arrested by Manhattan Beach Police on April 14, 2011. During the arrest, property was seized and is being maintained as evidence by Manhattan Beach PD (MBPD File No. 11-142). Among the property seized are two computers and 14 cellular phones. Could not recall her cell phone number, the carrier or an exact description of the phone she believes text message evidence is on. I believe there is probable cause to believe that the computers and cell phones contain evidence that would corroborate account of the criminal acts. (Addendum 8)

Based upon my training and experience I believe there is sufficient probable cause to search for any forms of written electronic communications. These communications include e-mails and/or cellular phone text messages between the suspects and the victims.

Based upon my training and experience I believe there is sufficient probable cause to search the suspect and his vehicle for any portable digital media devices that could contain evidence of the suspects contacting and/or communicating with the victims.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS REGARDING DIGITAL EVIDENCE:

As used below, the term "digital device" includes any electronic system or device capable of storing and/or processing data in digital form, including: central processing units; laptop or notebook computers; personal digital assistants;

wireless communication devices such as telephone paging devices, beepers, and mobile telephones; peripheral input/output devices such as keyboards, printers, scanners, plotters, monitors, and drives intended for removable media; related communications devices such as modems, cables, and connections; storage media such as hard disk drives, floppy disks, compact disks, magnetic tapes, and memory chips; and security devices. Based on my knowledge, training, and experience, as well as information related to me by agents and others involved in the forensic examination of digital devices, I know that data in digital form can be stored on a variety of digital devices and that during the search of the premises it is not always possible to search digital devices for digital data for a number of reasons, including the following:

- a. Searching digital devices can be a highly technical process that requires specific expertise and specialized equipment. There are so many types of digital devices and software in use today that it is impossible to bring to the search site all of the necessary technical manuals and specialized equipment necessary to conduct a thorough search. In addition, it may also be necessary to consult with specially trained personnel who have specific expertise in the type of digital device, software application or operating system that is being searched.
- b. Digital data is particularly vulnerable to inadvertent or intentional modification or destruction. Searching digital devices can require the use of precise, scientific procedures that are designed to maintain the integrity of digital data and to recover "hidden," erased, compressed, encrypted or password-protected data. As a result, a controlled environment, such as a law enforcement laboratory, is essential to conducting a complete and accurate analysis of data stored on digital devices.

- c. The volume of data stored on many digital devices will typically be so large that it will be highly impractical to search for data during the execution of the physical search of the premises. A single megabyte of storage space is the equivalent of 500 double-spaced pages of text. A single gigabyte of storage space, or 1,000 megabytes, is the equivalent of 500,000 double-spaced pages of text. Storage devices capable of storing 500 gigabytes (GB) of data are now commonplace in desktop computers. Consequently, each non-networked, desktop computer found during a search can easily contain the equivalent of 240 million pages of data, that, if printed out, would completely fill three 35' x 35' x 10' rooms to the ceiling. Further, a 500 GB drive could contain as many as approximately 450 full run movies of 450,000 songs.
- d. Electronic files or remnants of such files can be recovered months or even years after they have been downloaded onto a hard drive, deleted or viewed via the Internet. Electronic files saved to a hard drive can be stored for years with little or no cost. Even when such files have been deleted, they can be recovered months or years later using readily-available forensics tools. Normally, when a person deletes a file on a computer, the data contained in the file does not actually disappear; rather, that data remains on the hard drive until it is overwritten by new data. Therefore, deleted files, or remnants of deleted files, may reside in free space or slack space, i.e., space on the hard drive that is not allocated to an active file or that is unused after a file has been allocated to a set block of storage space for long periods of time before they are overwritten. In addition, a computer's operating system may also keep a record of deleted data in a swap or recovery file. Similarly, files that have been viewed via the Internet are automatically downloaded into a temporary Internet directory or cache. The browser typically

maintains a fixed amount of hard drive space devoted to these files, and the files are only overwritten as they are replaced with more recently viewed Internet pages. Thus, the ability to retrieve residue of an electronic file from a hard drive depends less on when the file was downloaded or viewed than on a particular user's operating system, storage capacity, and computer habits. Recovery of residue of electronic files from a hard drive required specialized tools and a controlled laboratory environment.

e. Although some of the records called for by this warrant might be found in the form of user-generated documents (such as word processor, picture, and movie files), digital devices can contain other forms of electronic evidence as well. In particular, records of how a digital device has been used, what it has been used for, who has used it, and who has been responsible for creating or maintaining records, documents, programs, applications and materials contained on the digital devices are, as described further in the attachments, called for by this warrant. Those records will not always be found in digital data that is neatly segregable from the hard drive image as a whole. Digital data on the hard drive not currently associated with any file can provide evidence of a file that was once on the hard drive but has since been deleted or edited, or of a deleted portion of a file (such as a paragraph that has been deleted from a word processing file). Virtual memory paging systems can leave digital data on the hard drive that show what tasks and processes on the computer were recently used. Web browsers, e-mail programs, and chat programs store configuration data on the hard drive that can reveal information such as online nicknames and passwords. Operating systems can record additional data, such as the attachment of peripherals, the attachment of USB flash storage devices, and the times the computer was in use. Computer file systems can record data about the dates files were created and the sequence in

which they were created. This data can be evidence of a crime, indicate the identity of the user of the digital device, or point toward the existence of evidence in other locations. Recovery of this data requires specialized tools and a controlled laboratory environment.

- f. Further, evidence of how a digital device has been used, what it has been used for, and who has used it, may be the absence of particular data on a digital device. For example, to rebut a claim that the owner of a digital device was not responsible for a particular use because the device was being controlled remotely by malicious software, it may be necessary to show that malicious software that allows someone else to control the digital device remotely is not present on the digital device. Evidence of the absence of particular data on a digital device is not segregable from the digital device. Analysis of the digital device as a whole to demonstrate the absence of particular data requires specialized tools and a controlled laboratory environment.
- g. Digital device users can attempt to conceal data within digital devices through a number of methods, including the use of innocuous or misleading filenames and extensions. For example, files with the extension ".jpg" often are image files; however, a user can easily change the extension to ".txt" to conceal the image and make it appear that the file contains text. Digital device users can also attempt to conceal data by using encryption, which means that a password or device, such as a "dongle" or "keycard," is necessary to decrypt the data into readable form. In addition, digital device users can conceal data within another seemingly unrelated and innocuous file in a process called "steganography." For example, by using steganography a digital device user can conceal text in an image file that cannot be viewed when the image file is opened. "Digital devices

may also contain "booby traps" that destroy or alter data if certain procedures are not scrupulously followed." A substantial amount of time is necessary to extract and sort through data that is concealed, encrypted, or subject to booby traps, to determine whether it is evidence, contraband or instrumentalities of a crime.

h. Any digital device seized pursuant to this warrant will be examined by law enforcement officers trained as digital evidence recovery specialists. In the course of their forensic process, they may "image", which is to forensically duplicate, the original evidence. This process ensures that the original seized evidence remains in the same condition as prior to its seizure. The duplicate image or copy will be maintained by the forensic examiner for court purposes.





Preliminary Investigative Narrative:

On January 20, 2011, at approximately 0300 hours, Officer Davis, Serial No. 39436, approached Sergeant Cohan, Serial No. 34916, Hollywood Morning Watch Commander, and advised him that his arrestee, wished to speak with a supervisor. Sergeant Cohan then directed Sergeant Martin, Serial No. 33678, to meet with who was seated inside holding tank number 125. After approximately 5-10 minutes of speaking with Sergeant Martin, and the sergeant Cohan that was alleging misconduct against an unknown police officer. Sergeant Cohan then met with the Complainant inside holding tank number 125 and interviewed her. The Complainant then stated to Sergeant Cohan that an unknown plain clothes officer forced her to orally copulate him approximately one year prior to the current date. Sergeant Cohan then summoned Sergeant Haines, Serial No. 32853, to assist him with the interview.

Sergeant Cohan notified Sergeant Velasquez, Serial No. 21880 of Internal Affiars, Classification Unit, who directed Sergeant Cohan to conduct a tape-recorded interview of the Complainant.

Sergeant Cohan and Sergeant Haines escorted the Complainant to interview room number 106 where they were met by female Detective Susan Brandstetter, Serial No. 27370. Detective Brandstetter's role was to remain in the interview room as a female Department employee witness only. Sergeant Cohan and Sergeant Haines conducted a video and audio-taped intake interview of the Complainant. The Complainant stated the following:

Approximatley one year prior to today's date (Winter 2009), the Complainant was walking her dog in a residential neighborhood somewhere within the Hollywood or West Hollywood community. As she walked her dog, a four-door Volkswagon Jetta approached her and parked near her. The Complainant recognized the two male occupants as plain clothes police officers with whom she had encountered in a past arrest. Both of the officers were in plain clothes in this encounter as well. One of the occupants told her to enter the vehicle in the rear passenger seat. The Complainant, believing she was being ordered for a possible investigation, complied with the command and sat down in the rear of the vehicle with her dog. The driver officer then got out of the vehicle and sat in the rear seat adjacent to the Complainant. The driver officer, who was now in the rear seat with her, took her dog and handed it to the other officer who was seated in the front passenger side. The passenger officer then got into the driver's seat and drove them for a short distance to an unknown location. The officer seated next to her stated to her, "Why don't you cut out that tough girl crap." The same officer then unzipped his pants and forced the Complainant's head down towards his lap and physically held her head down and forced her to orally copulated him. After some time, he then told her to get out of the car. She exited the car and the Jetta drove off.

The Complainant stated that she had not reported the incident due to the fact that she feared for her life and safety as a result of the nature of the incident. During the entire interview, the Complainant's behavior was erratic in that she would answer calmly and then moments later speak loudly and begin crying. The complainant further had difficulty understanding the interviewers' questions and admitted to being

was hesitant to trust the LAPD with her allegations of misconduct. was to report the misconduct because she was certain that she would be harmed had she done so. did not think anyone would believe her or that anything would be done.

On an unknown date in either 2009 or 2010, was walking her dog by herself on an unknown residential street in West Hollywood late in the evening. Two plain clothed LAPD narcotic officers in a light colored four door Volkswagen Jetta drove up next to her. Recognized the officers because they had once transported her for another unit that arrested her. was unable to recall which arrest it was or whether the officers transported her to a police station or to VNYS Jail. She had also seen the same plain clothed officers in the Volkswagen Jetta in the Hollywood area on several occasions when they approached her on the street and asked if she had any information regarding crimes.

described the driver officer as a male Hispanic, less than six feet tall with short black hair, average weight, and in his thirties. The passenger officer was a male White, approximately six feet tall with short brown hair, and also in his thirties.

Note: According to the California Department of Vehicle License records, Nichols is a male White, 5'6 tall, 145 pounds, blond hair, 40 years. Valenzuela is a male Hispanic, 5'8 tall, 150 pounds, black hair, 40 years.

The driver officer approached and asked her what she was doing out so late. He then ordered to get into the rear seat of their Volkswagen Jetta. The refused and the driver officer told her to "cut out all the tough girl bullshit and (they) would work a lot better together." Was unable to recall anything about the interior of the vehicle other than it was an automatic. They drove a few blocks away and parked. The driver officer told her, "I'm gonna get in the back seat with you." The driver officer sat next to her and took a hold of her dog. He told her that his partner could watch the dog and he threw the dog up to his partner in the front passenger seat. The passenger officer held the dog and remained looking forward, and he did not say anything during the entire incident.

The driver officer unzipped his pants and exposed his penis. He grabbed her hair and forced her head down towards his exposed penis. He told her, "If you don't suck my dick, you're going to jail" and then forced her to perform oral copulation on him. cheked several times. It was unknown whether he ejaculated or not. A short time later, the driver officer told her out of the vehicle. The driver officer told her that if she told anyone she would be in danger. Got out of the vehicle with her dog and the driver officer got back into the driver's seat and drove away.

was humiliated and embarrassed. She was uncertain if she told anyone what happened; however, if she had, she believed it would have been her friend, Cindy. could not recall Cindy's last name or her contact information or her whereabouts. saw the officers on a few occasions after that as she walked on the street. The driver officer appeared arrogant and on one occasion, asked her if she needed a beer. feared for he safety and did not report what happened to her.

Note: After the interview, was booked for her misdemeanor warrant and transported to VNYS Jail. While being evaluated at VNYS Jail, in had drastic mood swings from calm to angry. Cried and stated that she was tired of being pushed around and then commented that she wanted to kill somebody. As a result, she was transported to Harbor University of California Los Angeles (UCLA) and later released from custody.
